Description

To be able to loosen the casing screws with the impact wrench or casing wrench the casing screws need to be cleaned. In the square or hexagonal recesses there is heavily pressed drilling material. normally, this is laboriously scraped out with a screwdriver or drilled out with a masonry drill. Both are very time-consuming and cumbersome for the banksman. With common methods a cleaning right into the corners cannot be guaranteed without spending a lot of time on it.

To optimize the workflow on the construction site and to simplify the cleaning process, the new cleaning tool pipe screw can now be used for this work.

The tool is clamped in a cordless screwdriver and screwed into the casing screw like a drill. Tumbling movements are carried out by hand, which means that the tool also reliably cleans the corners of the screws.

A combination with the cleaning brush casing screw #1350054 results in an efficient and ergonomic workflow when installing and removing the casings
